We thank him for all his hard work since working with us here at Hanwood and wish him all the very best for the future. Shaun Braddock-Bould will be taking Tom's place. Many of you will have already met Shaun as he has been a regular coach in school covering absences and providing additional staffing where appropriate. Please ensure your child has their PE kit for the remainder of the week as additional PE sessions may take place throughout the week.

KS2 Summer Performance: Children in KS2 will be taking part in 'Aladdin', this Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> July at 2.00pm and 6.00pm. Hopefully you have all received your tickets - any outstanding requests to be made by Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> please. For the evening performance children need to return to school by 5.30pm please.
