KS1 Results 2016

Attainment

Pupils in 2016 were assessed against the new more challenging curriculum, introduced in 2014, for the first time this year. Results are no longer reported as levels, the interim frameworks for teacher assessment have been used by teachers to assess if a pupil has met the new, higher expected standard. The data below presents attainment based on teacher assessments. Because of these assessment changes, figures for 2016 are not comparable to those for earlier years as the expectations for pupils at the end of key stage 1 have been raised.

Standards for 2016 for our school are listed below with the national average being given in brackets.

Reading:

Percentage of pupils achieving expected standard or above: 84% (74%)

Percentage of pupils achieving a high standard: 53% (24%)

Writing

Percentage of pupils achieving expected standard or above: 84% (65%)

Percentage of pupils achieving a high standard: 37% (13%)

<u>Maths</u>

Percentage of pupils achieving expected standard or above: 84% (73% nationally)

Percentage of pupils achieving a high standard: 47% (18%)

Reading, Writing and Maths Combined

The percentage of children achieving the expected standard or better in reading, writing and maths: **79%** (60%)

The percentage of children achieving a high standard in reading, writing and maths: 37% (9%)
